TO LOG IN

- 1. Go to www.yogaconnection.org and click "View Our Current Schedule"
- 2. If you don't yet have a client account, click "Sign Up!" at the top right of the scheduling page to set up a username and password. You may also click "Sign Up!" to log in using a Facebook account. "Like" the Yoga Connection page to receive updates and special promotions.
- 3. Log in with your username and password

TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- 1. Once logged in, you will see seven tabs along the top of the page: Our Website, Classes, Workshops, Retreats, Teacher Training, Online Store, My Info, and Private Sessions.
- 2. Click the "Classes" tab
- 3. Click "Sign Up Now" next to the class you would like to take
- 4. On the next screen, you have a choice to Make a Single Reservation or Make a Recurring Reservation.
- 5. Your class card will automatically be debited if you have one, otherwise you will be prompted to pay online.

Note: Register for workshops by clicking the Workshops tab, and retreats by clicking on the Retreats tab.

TO SIGN UP FOR YOGA REWARDS

- 1. Log in with your username and password
- 2. You will be directed to a screen that allow you to opt in to our Yoga Rewards program
